

Ministry of Government Legislation shared Korea's experience in advancing legislation with Indonesia

The Ministry of Government Legislation (MOLEG, Minister Lee Wan-kyu) visited Indonesia to share Korea's experience in developing legislation on investment and social welfare, upon the invitation of the Cabinet Secretariat and the Ministry of Law and Human Rights of the Republic of Indonesia, for two nights and four days from August 6 to August 9, 2024. The delegation, comprised of Yoon Kang-wook, Director General of the Legislation Coordination Bureau of MOLEG and other legislative officers with abundant experience, discussed the current issues on legislative cooperation between the two countries.

On August 7, the delegation attended the "Seminar on Korea's Best Practices in Making Statutes on Investment and Social Welfare" hosted by the Cabinet Secretariat of Indonesia. Director General Yoon Kang-wook said in his congratulatory remarks, "I hope that Korea and Indonesia enhance the understanding of legislation of each country on economic investment and social welfare." Choi Jong-jin, Senior Legislative Officer, gave a

presentation on the history of legislation on social welfare and key statutes on social security. And Kim Hye-jung, Legislative Officer, delivered a presentation on the Framework Act on Administrative Regulation and regulatory innovation of Korea.

On August 8, the delegation met with Purnomo Sucipto, Deputy of Political, Legal, and Security Affairs of the Cabinet Secretariat. At the meeting, MOLEG invited the Cabinet Secretary of Indonesia to participate in the Asian Legislative Experts Symposium (ALES) to be held in November of this year. Additionally, we asked for their active cooperation in establishing the Council of Asian Legislative Institutions (CALI), which is joined by Asian countries, and they recognized the necessity of the consultative body.

In the afternoon of the same day, the delegation met with Director General of the Legislation Bureau of the Ministry of Law and Human Rights and talked about the ODA project to establish a legal information system in Indonesia and the signing of the Supplementary Agreement between MOLEG and the Ministry of Law and Human Rights. The two organizations agreed to cooperate closely together on these matters in the future.

Director General Yoon said, “Indonesia is a key country with which we have established a special strategic partnership. This visit has allowed us to disseminate Korea’s exemplary legislation to Indonesia and to expedite the establishment of the council for a stronger cooperation among Asian countries.”

MOLEG will make efforts to actively share Korea's advanced laws and systems with other Asian countries and to strengthen legislative cooperation to come up with measures to jointly respond

to the changes the world is facing such as climate change and development of artificial intelligence (AI).

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
